Visiting Imber Court – Some Useful Information

Car Parking	Please use the car parks accessed from the Rear Gate/South Entrance nearest Esher. Do NOT use the car park nearest the Police Sports Clubhouse. Please follow the instructions of the car park marshals, and do not block any driveways, roads or the bridges as they may be needed for Ambulance Access. If parking outside the club grounds, please do not park in coned off areas, or on the dangerous bend near the club entrance. Do not block residents' driveways. No parking on grass verges. Remember – it is the Metropolitan Police sports club, so please park considerately and safely!
Timings	Normally 10.00am to 12.00 noon
Squad Locations	U6 – in front of the main clubhouse U7, U8, U9 – on the cricket pitches U10, U11, U12 – on 40 Acres Field, across the river. U13, U14 – in the rugby stadium, across the river
Changing Facilities	There are excellent changing facilities, showers and toilets for both girls and boys located behind the main stadium
Food & Soft Drinks	There is a cafeteria open from early morning for food, hot & cold drinks in the main club house..
Refreshments	Please join us for a drink in the middle bar in the main clubhouse after the rugby finishes
Safety	Please note that a river runs through the middle of the sports club, near the changing rooms. Please ensure that all children are properly supervised, and are not allowed to play near the river. Please also be aware of potential dangers in the car park and access roads
First Aid	All age groups should have a First Aider on Duty, who will arrange for additional medical assistance if necessary. Only the First Aiders can give permission for injured players to continue playing. Further details from the First Aid Manager, Sue Thomas minis-first-aid@teddingtonrfc.co.uk
Dogs	Dogs are allowed in the grounds, but please keep them under control and remember that children play on the pitches!
